Primary to Secondary Transition 2022

I hope my letter finds you and your family well. Now that your son or daughter is in their final term of Year 6, the focus will begin to move towards their journey at Outwood Academy Adwick. Starting secondary school is an important, yet exciting time and one which we are really looking forward to sharing with them.

Here at Outwood Academy Adwick we want to ensure we do everything we can to reassure parents and carers that the transition from primary into secondary will be as positive as it can be. Thursday 14 July	All Year 6 students are invited to attend. Arrive from 8:20. Leave at 2:15pm. If you do not give permission for your child to leave at this time, please contact enquiries@adwick.outwood.com

In addition to this, we have a slightly modified transition programme for students identified by their year 6 teacher as benefiting from extended transition visits. If your child is invited to these, we will have already communicated this separately with your child's primary school.

We really do understand that this is a big change for you and your child and you may have a number of queries about what the curriculum will look like, what their timetable will involve, how your son or daughter should wear their uniform, or what our expectations are in terms of behaviour. The form will take you through a series of questions. While possible to complete on a mobile phone, it would be advisable to access the form on a tablet or computer.
