

### Post 16 Strike Action Provision

Dear parent/carer,

As you will already be aware teachers belonging to the National Education Union will be on strike on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July. As a result Outwood Academy Adwick and Outwood Academy Danum will close to years Y7, 8,9 unless they form part of the vulnerable cohort in which case a member of the Inclusion Team will contact you as those students will be expected to attend the provision on offer for the strike day.

All new Y13 (Y12) students will be expected to attend the Academy as normal on both days. Transport across sites will run as normal with students still accessing transport at 07:45 and 10:30 as normal to attend AM and PM lessons. Below is a list of the subjects that we anticipate will be running as normal.
