In summary

- All students will attend from 8:00 on Monday 20th June for their chemistry exam and then attend compulsory exam booster sessions until 12:00.
- At 12:00 on 20/6/22 students who are not studying food will be able to go home for study - but may stay onsite for lunch 12:00 - 12:30.
- Food students will leave after their exam.
- On Tuesday 21st June all students will attend compulsory exam booster sessions until 12:00, they may then leave for home study or remain onsite for lunch 12:00 - 12:30.
- On Wednesday 22nd June all students will attend from 8:25 for a cooked breakfast, with other alternative options, before then attending compulsory exam booster sessions until 12:00.
- At 12:00 on 22/6/22 students will be able to participate in their rites of passage shirt and book signing in the dining room.
- All students will attend from 8:00 on Monday 20th June for their Chemistry exam.
- Students will leave site after the Chemistry exam with the exception of business students who will attend a compulsory exam booster session until 13:30. (Lunch 12:00 - 12:30)
- On Monday 27th June, Polish students will attend from 8:00 for their exam and will leave the site afterwards.
- On Tuesday 28th June business students will attend from 8:25 until 10:25 for a compulsory exam booster session.
- On Wednesday 29th June, Business students will attend from 8:00 for their exam and will leave the site afterwards.

At 12:00 on Wednesday 22nd June students will be able to sign shirts and books with each other and their teachers in the dining hall.
