Two weeks ago, we delivered assemblies to all year groups along the theme of “What is your legacy?”. As part of this, we shared the stories of two inspirational young people; Lulu Blundell and Joe Lunn, who both, after being diagnosed with cancer aged 15, dedicated the rest of their lives to fundraising for young people facing cancer and their families. Their combined legacy is at almost £200,000 and this is something that we at Outwood Academy Adwick are desperate to continue.

We are planning a series of fundraising events in aid of the Teenage Cancer Trust in memory of Lulu and Joe. Our first event is the #Forever19 charity row/bike on Thursday 30th March 2023, where students and staff are covering the distance between Lulu’s and Joe’s hometowns (195 miles!) on rowing machines and exercise bikes.

We have been totally overwhelmed by the number of students volunteering to take part in the event and it is promising to be a fantastic day.
