

One academy blazer	Any additional uniform items:	
One academy skirt or trousers	Black <u>plain</u> school shoes – <i>polishable, must come below the ankle bone, not</i>	
One pack of 2 white, hard collar shirts	sandals/canvas/plastic etc	
One academy tie	Black tights (at least 40 denier) – for use with skirts	
One PE – games jersey	Black socks (plain) – for use with trousers (not skirts)	
One PE - shorts	Bag – big enough for an A4 folder

Uniform expectations

A smart uniform improves discipline, self-esteem and self-respect. Uniform focuses attention upon learning and away from distractions.

- Plain white shirt
- Plain black trousers or skirt
- School clip-on tie
- School jacket
- Plain black shoes
 - (No decorations, boots, pumps, canvas or trainer style)
- Plain black socks
- Optional V-neck school jumper
- School bag
 - Large enough for the school planner and A4 workbooks

PE uniform

- Plain purple or school polo top
- Purple / black school games top
- Black plain shorts
- Plain black knee length socks
- Trainers

What not to wear

- No nail polish
- No jewellery with exception to wrist watch
- No smart-watches
- Hairstyles and colour should be sensible
- Hair accessories must be black or purple
- No noticeable makeup

- Distinctive garments for religious reasons
- Medic alert necklace or bracelet




iPAY


